§ 78-18	Sewers and sewerage disposal	Not more than \$250 or prison not more than 15 days, or both in accordance with NYS Penal Law. A separate violation is deemed committed on each day during which an offense occurs or continues. A separate peanlty may be imposed for each separate violation

§ 94-27	Traffic infraction/violation of vehicles & traffic laws	First conviction: lot more than \$50 or prison for not more than 15 days, or both. Second conviction within 18 months thereafter: not more than \$100 or prison not more than 45 days, or both. Third conviction within 18 months after 1st conviction: not more than \$250 or prison not more than 90 days, or both.		
§ 97-9, 97-10	Water (line maintenance/repairs) tempering with hydrant/meter	ch 1-12 plus discontinuation of water service		
§ 100-62	Zoning -- criminal penalty	\$250 for each violation. Each and every day such violation continues may be deemed a separate and distinct violation		Not known to have ever been enforced. Lack of enforcement encourages violation?
§ 100-63	Zoning -- civil penalty	\$250 for each violation for each and every day it continues, recoverable by suit brought by the Vilage		Not known to have ever been enforced. Lack of enforcement encourages violation?
