Welcome to the 2022 Season!

Dear Members and Friends,

We are pleased to be sending out our annual letter and membership information as we approach our scheduled opening on Memorial Day weekend, Saturday, at 1:00 PM! The new Village Wee Wah Park Committee has worked hard to keep our membership fees the same as last season, considering mandatory increases in the minimum wage, insurance costs, and our partnership with the aquatic management firm, NYS Pools Management.

This season, you will note several improvements starting with adding new sand from Montauk, L.I., rebuilt horseshoe pits, new boundary lines on the volleyball court, removal of dead trees, dangerous fencing, and metal piping on the concrete structure.

We also removed some of the damaged toys and structures. Dogs will be allowed this season but must always be on a leash. If your dog becomes unmanageable, management will ask you to remove the dog. Of course, you must always clean up after your dog.

Our goal is to offer you a place to swim, relax and safely enjoy your summer.

Road Safety and Main Gate Procedure

What Hamlet Members Need to Know

Road Safety

Please drive slowly and carefully to the WWP&BC because we share the roads with many residents who are out jogging, cycling, or just taking a stroll. In cooperation with the Village Police Department, we ask all Hamlet members to adhere to the following procedures:

- Please access the Village via the main gate. Follow Tuxedo Road to Lorillard Road and then bear left onto Wee Wah Road to get to the Beach.
- As previously mentioned, we will be sharing the Village roads with many others. For safety, drivers must follow a recommended speed limit of 20 mph. I appreciate your cooperation.

Main Gate Procedure

The Village has a new way to enter the main gate. We purchased an automatic license plate reader that automatically scans your vehicle plate and opens the main gate for you. To offset the cost, the Village has established fees for Tuxedo Club, Tuxedo Park School, and seasonal members in the WWP&BC and WWFC.

The cost is \$9.95 for multiple vehicles. Register your car and purchase your pass at https://www.tuxedopark-ny.gov/vehicle-registration. You will be denied access without it. Lastly, on your first trip through the main gate, please have every member with a driver's license submit a copy of it to the police officer in the booth. I appreciate your cooperation.

Rules & Regulations of the Wee Wah Park & Beach Club

For Everyone's Enjoyment

- 1. Swimming is prohibited after 8:00 PM or 30 minutes before sunset, whichever is earlier, and at any time a lifeguard is not on duty.
- 2. Non-swimmers may not be on the waterfront without the direct supervision of a parent, guardian, or babysitter. Please check with a lifeguard regarding your child's swimming ability.
- 3. Children who have not completed 6th grade are not allowed at the Beach facility unless supervised by a parent, guardian, or babysitter. Babysitters must be at least 13 years old.
- 4. Children who have completed 6th grade may be at the Beach without supervision, provided they abide by all Beach rules.

- 5. Jumping off the dock or walls is prohibited.
- 6. Swimming under the dock or rough play on the dock is prohibited.
- 7. No glass containers are allowed in the sand area or beachfront.
- 8. Dogs will be allowed this season but must always be on a leash. If your dog becomes unmanageable, management will ask you to remove the dog. Of course, you must always clean up after your dog.
- 9. Ball playing is permitted on the grass area only, not in the sand.
- 10. No loud music.
- 11. Proper attire is to be constantly worn.
- 12. No fires or fire pits are allowed.
- 13. Everyone must take their trash with them when they leave.

- 14. No one under 21 can have alcoholic beverages at the Beach.
- 15. Anyone destroying or defacing property will be held responsible for payment and may lose membership privileges.
- 16. Membership in the Beach Club does not include membership in the Wee Wah Fishing Club. No fishing in the Park and the Beach.
- 17. Lifeguards are the authority at the Beach, so please follow their instructions. 18. The Village Board may suspend anyone who violates the abovementioned rules without reimbursing Membership fees.
- 19. No swimming beyond the roped area. 20. Hamlet members must give the village police a copy of their drivers licence.

Guest Passes

Please Use the Sign-in Sheet

- 1. People who are eligible to be members may not be guests.
- 2. All guests are subject to all rules.
- 3. Members MUST accompany guests to the Beach, sign them in, and always remain with their guests. Any member who fails to do so risks the loss of Guest Pass privileges.
- 4. Members must have Guest Passes to bring any guests, no matter the age of the Guest. 5. Members must be at least 18 years old to sign in as guests.
- 6. Children 12 (new this year) and under and Senior Citizens D.O. count toward your total number of Guest Passes.

What do I Need to Know About the Park's Hours of Operations

2022 Summer Season



This summer, the Park is open from sunrise to sunset, although you can visit the Park up to 11:00 PM if you respect our Village's noise and light ordinances.

Whom and when one can use the Park, and when one can swim fall into two buckets.

- 1) Village residents with and without Club Membership
- 2) Grandfathered Hamlet Members from 2019

Non-Member Village residents may use the Park from sunrise to 1:00 PM and after 8:00 PM to 11:00 PM. Swimming during these times **is not permitted** because there is no lifeguard on duty.

Non-Members Village residents must vacate the facilities by 1:00 PM daily so that paid members may have full use of the facility between 1:00 PM and 8:00 PM.

Village Residents who have purchased a membership may use the Park from sunrise until 11:00 PM and swim between 1:00 PM and 8:00 PM when the lifeguard is on duty.

2019 grandfathered Hamlet Members may only use the Park between 1:00 PM and after 8:00 PM.

The only time swimming in the lake is allowed (unless you own waterfront property or their guest on the Wee Wah Lake) is between 1:00 PM and 8:00 PM when the lifeguard is on duty. No swimming beyond the roped area.

*Note that weekday lifeguards do not start until school is out. These days there is no lifeguard on duty: June 1-3, June 6-10, and June 13-17

The 2022 summer swimming season, for members only, opens this Saturday, May 28th at 1:00 PM, and the season closes on Monday, September 5th at 8:00 PM.

As the season gets started, we will arrange for food truck services and musical entertainment during swimming hours of operation.

We are also planning some additional fun activities for the July 4th and Labor Day Holidays.
