Now therefore the Mayor revokes the appointment of Deputy Mayor Tinka Shaw as Deputy Mayor for the balance of the Village's 2023-24 official year.

WHEREAS the office of Deputy Mayor is now vacant, therefore the Mayor hereby appoints Trustee Christopher Kasker as Deputy Mayor for the balance of 2023-24 Village official year.

Trustee Kasker was then sworn in as Deputy Mayor by Clerk Doherty.
