At approximately 7:10 p.m. the Zoom broadcast was disconnected due to circumstances beyond the control of the Board. Deputy Mayor Shaw was terminated from the initial Zoom call but returned to the Board meeting via telephone and, in order to ensure compliance with open meetings law, was no longer counted towards a quorum and did not vote. Mayor McFadden, Trustee Brooke and Trustee Kasker made up the quorum for the remainder of the meeting.


