Contractor Activities

Arrived on site at 8:15 AM; two laborers from DPW were finishing up formwork and steel reinforcement tying prior to a scheduled 10:00AM concrete delivery from E. Tetz & Sons, Inc.

Formwork include rigid Styrofoam box out for a 4 inch masonry ledge on 3 sides of the foundation. Village (west) end of foundation has a reveal of 1 to 2 inches or less therefore no stone effacement will be constructed on this side of the foundation.

Utility box out is a 6.5" by 20" opening offset from the edge of the north side by 9" and from the west side by 33".

9:40 AM the Crew has completed formwork, reinforcement and applied bond breaker solution on the forms.

9:45 AM The concrete truck delivery arrived and the mix was batched at 8:57 AM. Delivery well with 90 minute window. 8.5 cubic yards delivered at specified slump of 4" and unconfined compressive strength of 4,500 psi per the delivery ticket. Delivery ticket from E. Tetz & Sons, Inc. attached with this report.

10:15 AM The foundation pour is complete and the crew is finishing the top surface with a screed, float and trowels.

11:00 PM Crew continues to finish top surface of concrete slab, are cleaning up project site.

11:30 PM Crew places tarp over completed slab to protect finish from threatening rain showers.

11:45 Light rain shower begins. Michael Quinn leaves site.

Discussion: Concrete foundation to cure for a couple of days and the forms may be stripped. Formwork contruction was done well with sufficient bracing and support. There was no visible deformation of the forms upon placement of concrete.


