NOVEMBER 12, 2025**

Attendees: Building and Land Use Officer John Ledwith and DPW Superintendent Jeff Voss. No members of the public were in attendance at Village Hall or via Zoom.

Mayor Citrin called the meeting to order at 10:04 a.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was made followed by roll call.

At the last Special Board of Trustees meeting on November 5th, the Board of Trustees reviewed a quote submitted by International Arkel Motors to repair one of the DPW dump trucks. DPW Superintendent Jeff Voss was not present at that meeting. Because the Board of Trustees had some questions that could not be answered the item was tabled. DPW Superintendent Voss said that the repair was important so at his request the Board of Trustees is meeting this morning to review the contract.

Mayor Citrin invited DPW Superintendent Voss to speak about the truck. Mr. Voss said that a salt spreader was going to be installed on the truck when it was discovered that the truck would not start. The DPW employees did some trouble-shooting without success. Mr. Voss called in a diesel mechanic for help and his response was that the truck needed a new motor. Mr. Voss contacted Arkel Motors for a second opinion. They agreed that the motor needed to be rebuilt and they also noted low compression in the cylinders and scarring on the cylinder walls. Mr. Voss said that because this truck is used to salt the roads in bad weather it is needed as soon as possible. At this time there is only one fully functional truck that can be used for salt spreading. Normally there are four.

The Mayor suggested that we consider entering into an on-site maintenance contract with a vendor or entering into an inter-municipal agreement with the Town of Tuxedo as they have a mechanic who performs ongoing maintenance of their vehicles to avoid costly repairs like this.

Be it resolved that the Village of Tuxedo Park authorize Arkel Motors, Inc. to rebuild and repair the engine of a DPW dump truck at a price of \$22,021.33 to be funded from budget line 5130.2 – Machinery-Equipment.
