2026 Recycling and Refuse Pick-up Schedule

Recycling

Paper Recycling

1. Newspapers with Inserts Tied in Bundles
2. Junk Mail with Envelopes and Coupons
3. Smooth and Corrugated Cardboard, Flattened Down and Tied
4. Office, Notebook and Construction Paper, Ledger and Envelopes of All Colors
5. Soft-Covered Workbooks, Telephone Books and Books (if Hardcover, Remove Cover)
6. Computer, Fax and Copy Paper of All Colors
7. Glossy Magazines and Catalogues
8. Brown Grocery Bags

Container Recycling

1. Plastic Containers with a Recycling Code #1-7
2. Aluminum Cans, Foils, and Disposable Aluminum Products
3. Metals Cans and Empty Aerosol Cans
4. Green, Clear and Brown Glass Bottles and Jars

Items that Are Not Recyclable

1. No paper soiled with grease, paint, etc.
2. No wax paper or paper cups
3. No tissues, napkins or paper towels
4. No paper items with layers of plastic or foil
5. No diapers, landscaping debris or food packaging
6. No plastic bags, film plastics or wrapping paper
7. No pots, pans, bowls, utensils or other cookware
8. No ceramic or glass plates and cups
9. No containers that held toxic substances (paint, oil, antifreeze, etc.)
10. No hangers, styrofoam, appliances, clothing or toys

Please place recycling at curbside on Wednesday by 5am

Paper items should be bundled and tied. Containers should be clean. Please place all items loosely in an open container. Recycling will not be picked up if it is in paper or plastic bags.

Garbage

Garbage collection is on Mondays and Thursdays.
Please put cans out the night before.

Garbage pickup will be the day after the following holidays:

New Year's Day – 1/1/2026 – Thursday
Memorial Day – 5/25/2026 – Monday
Labor Day – 9/7/2026 – Monday
Thanksgiving – 11/26/2026 – Thursday

Bulk/Large Item Pick-up

Acceptable Items for Pick-Up

1. Furniture, large appliances, anything made out of metal, old equipment, etc.
2. Electronics

Unacceptable Items for Pick-Up

1. Hazardous materials (antifreeze, pool chemicals, oil, batteries, paint)
2. Appliances using CFC's or refrigerants (air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, heat pumps, water coolers and dehumidifiers)
3. Glass such as windows, shower doors, patio doors, mirrors, etc.
4. Demolition debris, asphalt, bricks, dirt broken concrete, concrete blocks, rocks or roofing material.
5. Tires, automobile parts, boards, lumber, tree limbs, branches, stumps, trunks, grass and yard trimmings

This year's bulk pick-up will be on the following days:

* Spring: May 9th *
* Fall: October 10th *
